FROM THE DESK OF GENERAL SECRETARY

NEWS LETTER NO 2/2009 D.29.10.2009

Dear Alumni Members,

Belated Greetings for Dasara and Deepavali and advance greetings for a Happy New Year.

Here I am with you through this second news letter to share the news and views which took place from the time the First news letter till today.

1. REVIEW OF THE FIRST NEWS LETTER

The top most priority for this Executive Body is to generate a corpus fund of Rs. 20 Lakhs as early as possible through Life membership drive, Voluntary contributions and through Souvenir printing. There is a good beginning and it is hoped that we reach the target in the allocated time period. I am glad to inform that the batches later than 1988 are being invited to take part in the Alumni activities dispelling the apprehension from these batch students that there are being sidelined. As I mentioned in my earlier news it was decided during the second Executive committee meeting held on 29.03.2009, to welcome the younger lot to join the Alumni and strengthen it. It is a general prudence, to involve the students belonging to Nalgonda, to strengthen the Alumni activities as they have more responsibility in the present scenario.

2. HOMEOPATHIC MEDICINES DISRIBUTION FOR SWINE FLU PREVENTION D.22.08.09

Dr. Girivardhan (Homeopathy) of 1990 batch has come forward with to distribute preventive homeopathic medicines for Swine Flu, which during Jun-Sept has created panic all over India. Dr Girivardhan along with President, D Sathyanarayana and the General Secretary K. Shantha Nanda Prasad, have gone to the school and distributed medicines worth around Rs.12,000/- to the students of School and Junior College. Dr. Girivardhan has educated the students about Swine Flu symptoms and its prevention.

3. MEDICAL CAMP, CAREER GUIDANCE CAMP WITH GOLD MEDAL DISTRIBUTION ON D.11.10.2009

A team of 05 Doctors comprising Dr Linga Reddy (81), Dr Chandrasekhar (83), Dr Rajamallu (87), Dr Yadagiri (99) and Dr Kiran (2001), have conducted medical camp which commenced at 10.00 AM and continued upto 2.00 PM. Dr Raghu (75), Vasudeva Rao (76), Dr Arjun (79), Dr Vijaya Bhargava (84), and Dr P Sridhar (86) have voluntarily contributed medicines for distribution for children worth around Rs. 10,000/-. One of the student by name Kranthi (10th class) was suspected to have medical problem was referred to Dr Sridhar (86), Cardiologist at Apollo Hospital, Jubilee Hills. After thorough examination, it was found that he has Asthma and accordingly advised prescription and precaution.

Shri Veera Mahender (76), Vice President has partly contributed towards the travel expenditure. While the medical camp is on, career guidance programme was conducted parallelly for the outgoing batch of 10th class students explaining the various career options available for them by Shri MA Rajasekhar Reddy (80). The importance of English was emphasized by Shri Ramana Reddy (81) and advised the students to practice speaking in English to overcome the fear of foreign language. Shri K Shantha Nanda Prasad (86) has delivered a motivational lecture with a special relevance to the career of their choice.

Gold Medals were distributed to the students who topped in 10th class during the years 2007-08 and 2008-09, sponsored by S/Shri D Sathyanarayana (75), President and P Sathyanarayana Rao (85) respectively. Shri B Nagi Reddy who secured 572 out of 600, during 2007-08, presently pursuing Intermediate (MPC) at Chaitanya Junior College, Vijayawada and Shri B Shiva who secured 575 out of 600 during 2008-09, presently studying at IIIT, Basara, were presented the Gold Medals. On this occasion, we are fortunate to have Shri Venkataiah Sir (old teacher) with us, guiding teachers and students.

4. CORPUS FUND CONTRIBUTION FROM NARAYANA ASHOK REDDY (1986)

As I was mentioning in my earlier correspondence, it is desired to have a Corpus Fund to a tune of Rs.20.00 lakhs to sustain the Alumni activities.
